Christianity God

How does the way we treat the world matter?

We will look at Christian beliefs about God as creator and sustainer, and consider how these beliefs might influence Christian attitudes towards the planet. We will explore how Christians might express their beliefs and values through acts of stewardship and/or through harvest festivities.



Hinduism

How might people show their devotion?


We will explore the purpose of and some of the practices associated with Hindu worship. We will focus on the beliefs about Brahman, family, community and Worship. We will investigate ways that Hindus might express their devotion to God through worshipping the deities.



Christianity Jesus

Why do Christians say that Jesus is the 'light of the world'?

We will explore the use of light to and how it might be used in religious communities to indicate the presence of God and as a description for Jesus as God incarnate. We will look to make links between the imagery and symbolism of light in the Christian context and significant events in our own lives.



Islam

Why do Muslims believe it is important to obey God?

We will examine Islamic beliefs and practices linked to prayer and will explore the significance of prayer as one of the Five Pillars of Islam and consider the purpose of prayer for religious people. We will explore rituals and how these might unite communities and give a sense of order, security and belonging to individuals.



Christianity The Church

What unites the Christian Community?

We will explore the core beliefs and symbols of Christianity and learn that belief in one God and Jesus Christ unite the Christian community and that the cross is an important Christian symbol. We learn about the importance of the church as a place to bring together the community for worship and Christian fellowship.



Sikhism

Does worship help people?

We will examine how aspects of worship enhance Sikh practice and beliefs. The content focus is on God, The Guru Granth Sahib and Worship. We will explore the role of the Gurdwara as a focus for worship and consider places and activities that enhance their lives.
