Christianity The Church

How do people decide what to believe?

We will explore Christian beliefs and teachings contained in the Apostle's Creed and how shared beliefs unite the world-wide Church. We will explore the idea of one God in Trinity and be able to explain the role of each person of the Trinity. We will begin to explore diversity within Christianity by looking at differences in worship.



Buddhism

What can stories teach us?

We will examine how Buddhist teachings are organised and disseminated. The content focus is on The Buddha, The Dharma and The Sangha. We will explore the source of and forms of teachings found in Buddhist literature.



Christianity Jesus

What do we mean by a 'miracle'?

We will explore what the Christian belief in Jesus as 'fully human and fully divine' means and will build on our prior learning about the incarnation and consider why some people regard the miracles of Jesus as signs of his divine nature. We will investigate why some Christians might want to travel to a place associated with a miracle.



Sikhism

Why do people follow sacred books?

We will examine how the teachings of Sikh Dharam are revealed and applied to daily life. The content focus is on God and The Guru Granth Sahib. We will explore the content of the Guru Granth Sahib, its role in worship and examples or teachings revealed in it. We will relate this to principles of value in our lives.



Christianity God

Why is it sometimes difficult to do the right thing?

Will explore Christian beliefs and teachings about sin and temptation and introduce core Christian concepts such as The Fall, Original Sin, Free Will, forgiveness and reconciliation. We will investigate the importance of forgiveness within the Christian faith and the way this might be put into action by both individuals and communities.



Judaism

What can we learn from the way Jews treat their scriptures?

In this unit we will examine how God's will is revealed to the Jewish people in the Torah. The content focus includes God, Torah and The Land and The People. We will explore organisation, content and practices associated with the Torah.
