- Begin to understand the 5 key concepts about print.
- Develop phonological awareness - spot rhymes, count syllables, recognise words with the same initial sound.
- Engage in conversations about stories.
- Learn new vocabulary.
- Use some print and letter knowledge in early writing.
- Practise name writing.

Mathematics

Numbers to 5

- Recite numbers past 5.
- Say one number for each item in order: 1, 2, 3
- Show 'finger numbers' up to 5.
- Link numerals and amounts.
- Count objects, actions and sounds.
- Experiment with symbols, marks and numerals.

- Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural celebrations
- Give examples of special occasions and suggest features of a good celebration.
- Recall simple stories connected with Christmas / Harvest / Diwali and Eid.
- Say why festivals are special times for believers of different faiths.

- Use a variety of tools and techniques including different brush sizes and types.
- Express ideas and feelings through making marks, and sometimes give a meaning to the marks they make.
