Nits

Please be aware that we have been informed of a case of headlice (nits) in Key Stage 1. Please make sure you check your child's hair carefully this weekend and treat as appropriate.

Online Safety

It has come to our attention that many of the children in school are using apps and playing on games outside of their age range. Whilst we understand the social pressure for children to be on these games/ apps and they may enjoy being on them, there are reasons that they have suggested age minimum limits. Please also consider how much time your child is spending on the app/ game for because this can have a profound negative effect on them.

We are noticing that the children are becoming less focused in class, more argumentative with their friends and sometimes behaving in an unkind way. They are also focusing on these games rather than on their lessons and 'planning' what they are going to do later. They may also be seeing age-inappropriate material. It appears to be having a negative effect on their mental health and wellbeing. I am therefore including the recommended age limits for different apps/ games below. Most are 12+. This means that it is not appropriate and potentially harmful for your primary school age child to be using some of them.

Whilst this is an 'outside of school' issue, we feel it is important that we draw your attention to the negative impact it is having in school. We would urge you to consider removing any age inappropriate apps and games from your child's phone/ devices and explain to them why you are doing this. They have lots of time in school to talk and play with their friends so do not need to worry about 'missing out'.

Outstanding payments
