Uniform Policy

We have updated our school uniform policy, taking into consideration the views of parents/carers, pupils and staff. Our school uniform is available from 1st Class Kids in Blackpool, however some items can be purchased from your preferred supermarket or retail store such as: -shirts trousers, socks etc.

Children should wear:

- Navy Blue school logo jumper or cardigan
- Tailored grey trousers or shorts
- Tailored tartan skirt or pinafore dress
- Tailored school check kilt or pinafore dress
- White shirt (not a polo shirt)
- School tie (children in EYFS may wear an elastic tie)
- White or grey socks or tights
- Sensible black shoes with grip (no trainers, shoe trainers or boots (including ankle boots)).
- Navy Blue school logo blazer (this is optional)

Children in ***Foundation Stage (EYFS)*** can wear the school tie on a piece of elastic. From Year 1 upwards we encourage a move away from elastic ties and so teaching your child to tie a tie helps them in school.

During the summer term and the first half of the autumn term, summer dresses in school navy check may be worn, along with sensible sandals in brown, black or white.

Outdoor Clothing

Your child should bring a coat to school every day. In cold weather, children can wear hats, gloves and scarves, and in the summer months, sun hats or caps should be provided.

PE Kit

Children can attend school in their PE Kit on the days they have PE in School. The teacher will inform you of the days on their Dojo

- Navy Blue shorts (logo)
- Navy Blue T-shirt (logo)
- Plain black or navy blue jogging bottoms school logo if preferred otherwise (no logos or decoration)
- Trainers (these should be dark colours and as plain as possible)

Navy blue school book bags (no ruck sack types please) lack of space prohibits the bringing of large bags, children should not bring any other school bag.

Each child in KS1 will need a navy blue reading book carrier, which may be purchased from our school outfitters. These fit easily into the children's trays neatly which helps to keep the classrooms safe and tidy

Stationery is provided for all children every day by school and therefore children are not required to bring in pencil cases or other stationery items.

Water Bottles

All children are asked to bring in a water bottle each day. This must only be plain water. We will not allow water bottles that have a screw bottle top lid. This is because they are easy to spill and cause damage to books and pupil's work. The water bottle should only have water in it (no juices please)



Jewellery

Only the following items of jewellery can be worn in school:

- A wristwatch (this should not be a SMART watch)
- Children may wear a small pair of earring studs in silver or gold, which will need to be covered or removed for certain activities. Earrings should be plain and not decorative.
- Jewellery of any other description is not permitted. This includes holiday bracelets which should be removed before children return to school.
- Children with long hair should have it tied back and only school colours navy blue/white hair adornments should be worn.
- Sparkles and large bows are not allowed.
- Coloured hair braids (often following holidays) should also be removed before children return to school.
- We ask that children do not wear hair gel.
- Shaved hair patterns are not permitted, including closely-shaved heads: no cuts below Grade 2.
- Children should not have fashion haircuts in school such as mixing short on the sides and long on top. We suggest if you have a holiday haircut this is at the start of the holiday so children can return with hair in line with the policy at the start of the school term.
- Children should have short nails when in school. Please note that children should not wear nail varnish.

Mobile Devices and Phones

- Mobile phones are not allowed in school. Children in Year 6 may bring a phone which can be stored in the classroom with the class teacher's permission or can be left in the school office until the end of the day.
- A wristwatch - this should not be a SMART watch and any watch that has the ability to access the internet, take photographs, receive text messages etc. (Fitbit Charge or Apple watches) should not be worn at school.
- Children can wear a simple and inexpensive band style watch without an interactive face or screen that can also track activity and steps if they wish.

Name Labels

Please ensure that all items of clothing, which your child is likely to remove or put on during the school day, are clearly named. School cannot accept responsibility for lost clothing or items. The school accept no responsibility for any losses or damage caused to property while in school. We ask that you ensure that all items including clothing, shoes and bags are clearly marked with your child's name.
