Jesus

Why do Christians say that Jesus is the 'light of the world'?

We will explore the use of light to and how it might be used in religious communities to indicate the presence of God and as a description for Jesus as God incarnate. We will look to make links between the imagery and symbolism of light in the Christian context and significant events in our own lives.



Hindu Dharma

How might people show their devotion?

We will explore the purpose of some of the practices associated with Hindu worship. We will focus on the beliefs about Brahman, family, community and Worship. We will investigate ways that Hindus might express their devotion to God through worshipping the deities.



We will look at Christian beliefs about God as creator and sustainer, and consider how these beliefs might influence Christian attitudes towards the planet. We will explore how Christians might express their beliefs and values through acts of stewardship and/or through harvest festivities.



We will explore the core beliefs and symbols of Christianity and learn that belief in one God and Jesus Christ unite the Christian community and that the cross is an important Christian symbol. We learn about the importance of the church as a place to bring together the community for worship and Christian fellowship.



Islam

Why do Muslims believe it is important to obey God?

We will examine Islamic beliefs and practices linked to prayer and will explore the significance of prayer as one of the Five Pillars of Islam and consider the purpose of prayer for religious people. We will explore rituals and how these might unite communities and give a sense of order, security and belonging to individuals.



Judaism

What aspects of life really matter?

We will examine Jewish beliefs and practices linked to the Sabbath (Shabbat) and explore the significance of the Sabbath and why Jewish people keep the day holy. Within this, we will discuss the importance of holy days and how these might unite families and give time to spend together.
