# Staining CE Primary School Uniform Policy

We have updated our school uniform policy, taking into consideration the views of parents/carers, pupils and staff. Our school uniform is available from 1st Class Kids Highfield Road South Shore Blackpool FY4 2 JF

All items of school clothing must be selected from the school uniform list. All items are required but there may be more than one choice. For example - a checked kilt is available but is not compulsory. The only exception is the school blazer which remains optional. The only required branded items in our uniform policy, which are required with our school badge on, are the school jumper/cardigan and the school sport top. These branded/badged items are available at our school uniform shop 1st Class Kids. All other items can be purchased as generic items with no specific uniform supplier.

Please note: Our school uniform is not gender specific.

## School Uniform Required:

- · Navy Blue/ pale blue trimmed school jumper or cardigan with school badge (branded)
- · Grey trousers or shorts

- · Grey skirt or pinafore dress or school check kilt or pinafore dress
- · White shirt
- · School tie
- · White or grey socks or tights
- · Black shoes
- · Navy Blue school blazer (optional)

### Additional Summer Uniform items:

- · Navy Blue check school dress
- · Sandals (black, brown)

During the summer term and the first half of the autumn term, summer dresses in school navy check may be worn, along with sensible sandals in black or brown. Shorts can be worn at any time of year. Children in Foundation Stage (EYFS) can wear the elasticated school tie. From Year 1 upwards we encourage a move away from elastic ties and so teaching your child to tie a tie helps them in school.

# Outdoor Clothing

Your child should bring a coat to school every day. In cold weather, children can wear hats, gloves and scarves, and in the summer months, sun hats or caps should be provided.

Children attend school in their Sport Kit on their designated PE day. They can wear outdoor clothing on their Outdoor Learning Day. These will be notified to parents via the class teacher on Dojo.

#### Sport Kit

School tracksuit top or your existing school tracksuit bottoms or school tracksuit leggings or any plain black/navy blue tracksuit bottoms or leggings. These should have no decoration including mesh panels or branding logos.

In hot weather, plain black shorts/leggings to the knee

White Tee shirt (with OR WITHOUT school logo)

Trainers with minimally sized logo (No bright or neon colours; not fashion trainers)

# School bags

Lack of space prohibits the bringing of large ruck sacks or back packs type bags, children should not bring any other school bag except their school book bags or cloth bag which will only contain their school books. Each child will need a navy blue reading book carrier, which may be purchased from our school outfitters.

In Reception, all pupils will receive a navy blue book bag from the school PTA once they start school. Parents do not need to purchase any other bag for school. This smaller version fits into children's trays neatly and really helps us to keep the classrooms safe and tidy.

Year 1 and Year 2 pupils can still use the smaller book bag, however, you can to purchase one of the larger bags from 1st Class Kids.

In Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 our preference is the larger of the two versions of the navy blue bags.

# Stationery

In all classes, all stationery is provided every day by school and therefore children are not required to bring in pencil cases or other stationery items.

# Water Bottles

All children are asked to bring in a water bottle each day. This must only be plain water. We will not allow water bottles that have a screw bottle top lid. This is because they are easy to spill and cause damage to books and pupil's work. The water bottle should have the following:

Any like these with a funnel, a spout or a straw are fine. If knocked over they do not spill

Any water bottle that has a value of more than £10 should not be brought into school. This includes scent water such as air up bottles.

#### Children's Hair

Children with hair that is long enough to be tied back, should have it tied back, and only white/yellow/black/purple hair adornments should be worn. Sparkles and large bows are not allowed. Coloured hair braids (often following holidays) should also be removed before children return to school. We ask that children do not wear hair gel. Shaved hair patterns are not permitted. Children should not have fashion haircuts in school such as mixing short on the sides and long on top. We suggest if you have a holiday haircut this is at the start of the holiday so children can return with hair in line with the policy at the start of the school term.

### Children's Nails

Children should have short nails when in school. Please note that children should not wear nail varnish.

### Mobile Devices and Phones

Mobile phones are not allowed in school. However, we realise that some children need their phones when they are walking to school and then home at the end of the day. If your child has their phone when they arrive at school they will need to drop them off at the school office an collect them as they leave the school premises at the end of the day.

# Jewellery/Watches

A small pair of inexpensive stud earnings may be worn. These should be plain and silver or gold metal. Please note that they may need to be removed or covered up with tape for certain activities. Ear piercing should be carried out during the

summer holidays to allow time for the healing process. Please note that jewellery of any other description is not permitted. This includes holiday bracelets which should be removed before children return to school.

A wristwatch - this should not be a SMART watch and any watch that has the ability to access the internet, take photographs, receive text messages etc. (for example, FitBit Blaze, FitBit Charge or Apple watches) should not be worn at school. Children can wear a simple and inexpensive band style watch without an interactive face or screen that can also track activity and steps if they wish.

### Name Labels

Please ensure that all items of clothing, which your child is likely to remove or put on during the school day, are clearly named. School cannot accept responsibility for lost clothing or items. The school accept no responsibility for any losses or damage caused to property while in school. In order to help your child to take care of their property we ask that you ensure that all items including clothing, shoes and bags are clearly marked with your child's name.
