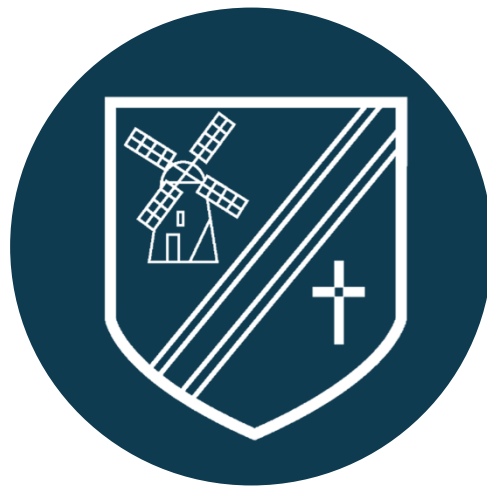

UNIFORM POLICY



Uniform Policy

We have updated our school uniform policy, taking into consideration the views of parents/carers, pupils and staff. Our school uniform is available from 1st Class Kids in Blackpool, however some items can be purchased from your preferred supermarket or retail store such as: shirts, trousers, socks etc.

Children should wear:

Winter uniform

Staining logo cardigan or jumper
Tartan pinafore or skirt
Dark grey trousers
Blue school tie
Plain white school shirt (no frills)
Black school shoes
Navy, grey or black tights
White, grey or navy socks

Summer uniform

Staining logo cardigan or jumper
Blue school tie
Plain white school shirt (No frills)
Dark grey school shorts Grey,
Black socks
Black school shoes
Navy gingham school dress
White or navy socks (no big frills)
Bows - Small school colours only (optional)

Our PE Kit

Staining logo PE tracksuit
Staining logo PE top (compulsory)
Staining logo shorts
Black, navy or white socks
Suitable PE trainers must be worn. These should be designed for sport; fashion trainers are not acceptable.
Alternative option:

Plain navy joggers or leggings.

Plain navy shorts

Plain navy jacket (No brands/logos).

Please remember all school uniform should be clearly labelled with your child's name. At Staining Primary School, we encourage smart uniforms and tidy hairstyles. Extreme hairstyles or cuts (such as Mohicans), patterns, or dyed hair are not permitted. Hair that is longer than shoulder length should be tied back. Hair accessories, such as bows, are allowed (provided they are small and in school colours).



Children in **Foundation Stage (EYFS)** can wear the school tie on a piece of elastic. From Year 1 upwards we encourage a move away from elastic ties and so teaching your child to tie a tie helps them in school.

During the summer term and the first half of the autumn term, summer dresses in school navy check may be worn.

Outdoor Clothing

Your child should bring a coat to school every day. In cold weather, children can wear hats, gloves and scarves, and in the summer months, sun hats or caps should be provided.

Stationery is provided for all children every day by school and therefore children are not required to bring in pencil cases or other stationery items.

Water Bottles

All children are asked to bring in a water bottle each day. This must only be plain water. We will not allow water bottles that have a screw bottle top lid. This is because they are easy to spill and cause damage to books and pupil's work. The water bottle should only have water in it (no juices please).

Jewellery

Only the following items of jewellery can be worn in school:

- A wristwatch (this should not be a SMART watch)
- Children may wear one small pair of earring studs (no hoops). Earrings must be removed before PE lessons, and children must be able to remove them independently. Please ensure any new ear piercings are done during the summer holidays to allow sufficient healing time before returning to school.
- Jewellery of any other description is not permitted. This includes holiday bracelets which should be removed before children return to school.
- Children with long hair should have it tied back and only school colours navy blue/white hair adornments should be worn.
- Sparkles and large bows are not allowed.
- Coloured hair braids (often following holidays) should also be removed before children return to school.
- Shaved hair patterns are not permitted, including closely-shaved heads: no cuts below Grade 2.
- Children should not have fashion haircuts in school such as mixing short on the sides and long on top. We suggest if you have a holiday haircut this is at the start of the holiday so children can return with hair in line with the policy at the start of the school term.
- Children should have short nails when in school. Please note that children should not wear nail varnish.
- Children can wear a simple and inexpensive band style watch without an interactive face or screen that can also track activity and steps if they wish.
- A wristwatch - this should not be a SMART watch and any watch that has the ability to access the internet, take photographs, receive text messages etc. (Fitbit Charge or Apple watches) should not be worn at school.



Mobile Devices and Phones

- Mobile phones are not allowed in school. Children in Year 6 may bring a phone which can be stored in the school office until the end of the day.

Name Labels

Please ensure that all items of clothing, which your child is likely to remove or put on during the school day, are clearly named. School cannot accept responsibility for lost clothing or items. The school accept no responsibility for any losses or damage caused to property while in school. We ask that you ensure that all items including clothing, shoes and bags are clearly marked with your child's name.
